

Can I Submit Multiple Abstracts?

First Author Policy: First Authors can have a maximum of one (1) contributed and one (1) invited abstract, or two (2) invited abstracts. The only exemption to this policy is the submission of one (1) additional contributed abstract to an GeoHealth (GH), Education (ED), or Public Affairs (PA) session.

Do you want to submit more than one abstract?

Then you are all set! View accepted sessions and begin your submission.

Are you an invited author on a session? (You would have received a special email with a link to submit your invited abstract to that session).

Yes



Great! You can submit a total of 2 abstracts: 2 invited, or 1 invited + 1 contributed abstract.

Are any of the sessions you are trying to submit to in the GeoHealth (GH), Education (ED), or Public Affairs (PA)

Then you can only submit the one contributed (regular) abstract.

Yes



Great! You can submit another contributed abstract if the session is primarily listed in GH, ED, or PA.

Linked Notes:

- Session conveners may not be the first author or presenter on an invited abstract in the session they are convening.
- Conveners are also subject to the First Author Policy.
- You must be an AGU member to submit an abstract. Join or renew.
- The first author is automatically the person submitting the abstract.
- The presenting author can be changed to a co-author listed on the abstract by the first author.
